

KSI - Bodies & Senses

Session Overview

This session aims to reinforce children's knowledge of body parts and senses by comparing human bodies to monkeys and apes. Through use of images, video and audio the class will compare and contrast how human and non-human primates use their bodies and senses every day. Why is it important to see in colour? What does a tail do? Which sense is most important for monkeys? At the end of the session, everyone will be up on their feet for Heads, Shoulders, Knees & Toes... but with a twist!

Learning Outcomes:

- Each child will understand that animals use sense to see, hear, smell, taste and feel
- Each child will understand that while primates' bodies differ in size and shape, they have the same functions as human body parts
