

KS2 - Life cycles

Session Overview

During this session, pupils will compare and contrast non-human primate life cycles to our own. Being part of the primate family, we share many similarities with our ape cousins, including within our life cycles. Children will be encouraged to discuss how our lives differ from those of monkeys and apes, considering *why* these differences may occur. At the end of the session, the pupils' learning will be solidified through a quiz and worksheet.
