Why are primates endangered and why do we rescue them?

To learn more about Monkey World's work in primate rescue work through the slides on our **Conservation & Rescue** lesson, then complete the follow-up activities

**Monkey World founded the Endangered Asian Species Trust in 2008 to protect and conserve wild primate species in Vietnam. EAST rescues, rehabilitates and releases golden-cheeked gibbons, black-shanked douc and pygmy loris that have been victims of the illegal wildlife trade.**

This week we want you to research all about EAST and the species that they care for. Visit [www.go-east.org](http://www.go-east.org) and visit their social media pages (with adult supervision!) to investigate their work. Create a poster, leaflet, video or other informative display to teach others about EAST. Can you also find out the answers to these questions and include them in your work?

- Why is it important to conserve golden-cheeked gibbons? Is it just because we like them?
- Why can't the gibbons be released into the wild immediately after rescue?
- Why do the EAST team track the released gibbons using radio collars?

#### Project Idea 1

Create a board or card game to show a primate's journey through rescue, rehabilitation and release.

Let your imagination run wild and invent your own game or take inspiration from one that already exists.

#### Project Idea 2

Pick your favourite primate at Monkey World and find out where they were rescued from and why. Present their story.
